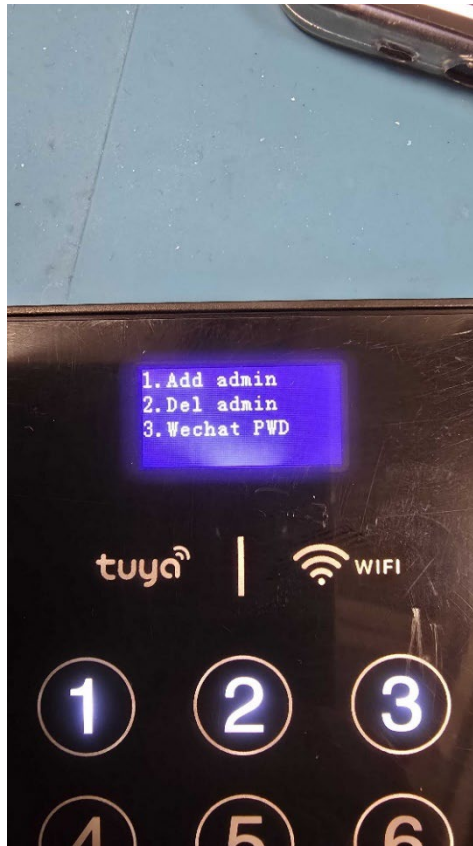
First boot of the device

First, you need to connect the device to the power supply. Once you have enabled it, the next step is to add an administrator.

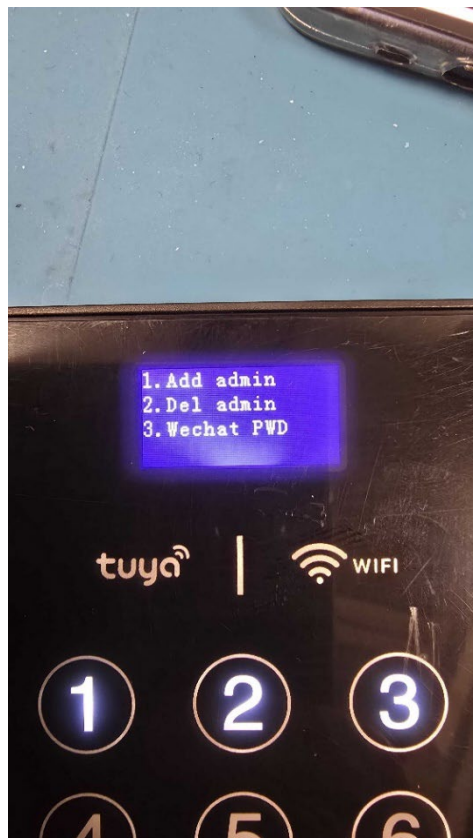
To do this, enter the menu by pressing the * key and then #



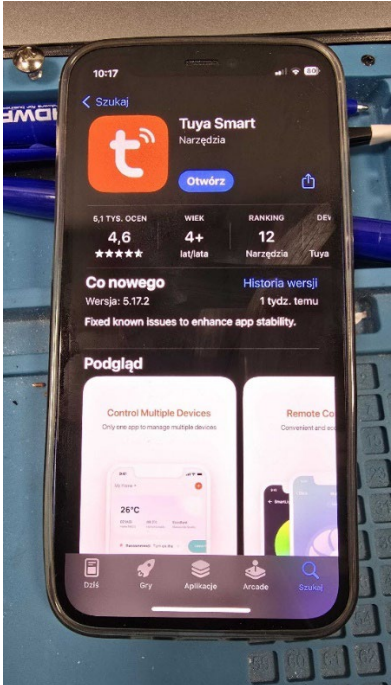
To add an administrator, press button 1. The administrator menu will be displayed, in which we press the 1 key again.



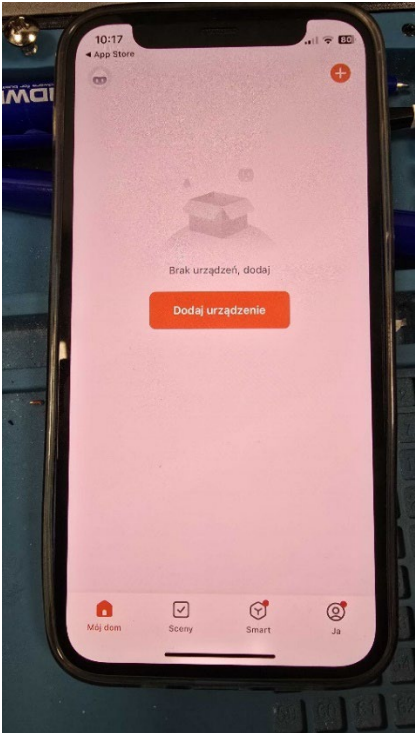
Then you need to add a fingerprint, password, or RFID card to add an administrator.



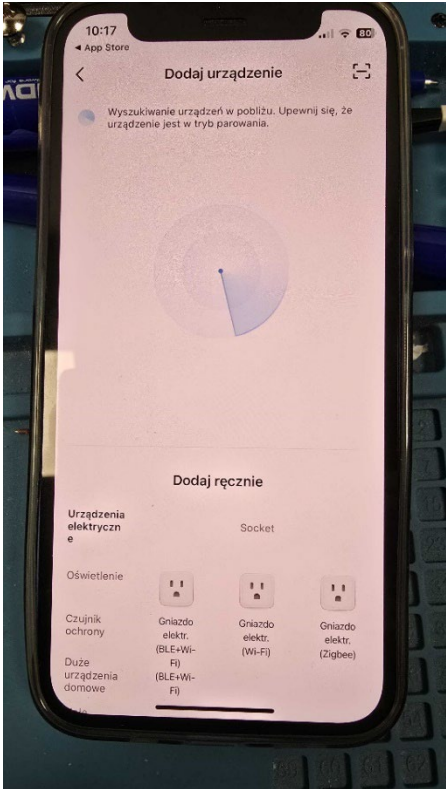
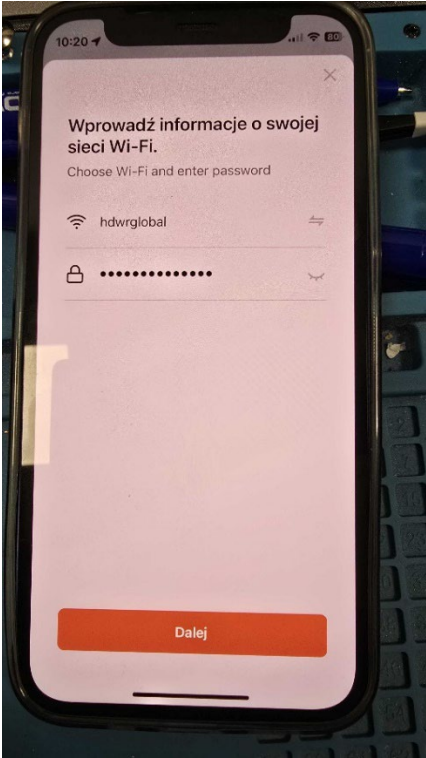
Once you have added the administrator, the next step is to install the Tuya app on your mobile phone. The application is available on Google Play and Appstore.



After installing the application, you need to log in or if you do not have an account, register. Once you've completed these steps, you'll need to add the device.



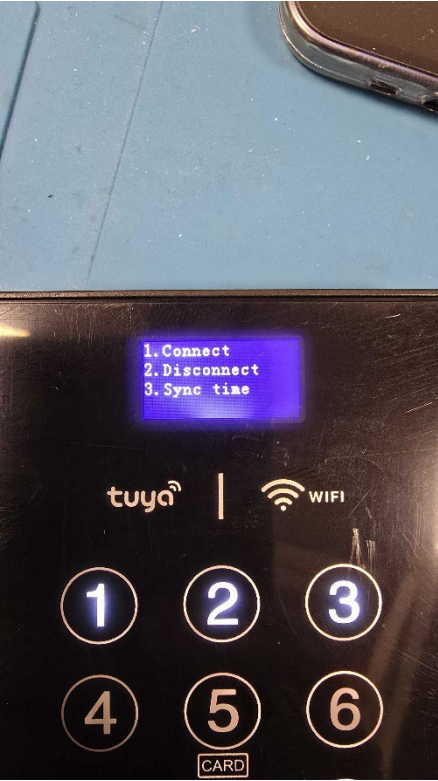
At this point, the application requires logging in to the Wi-Fi network (the phone and the device must be within range of the router), Bluetooth and GPS must also be enabled on the phone.



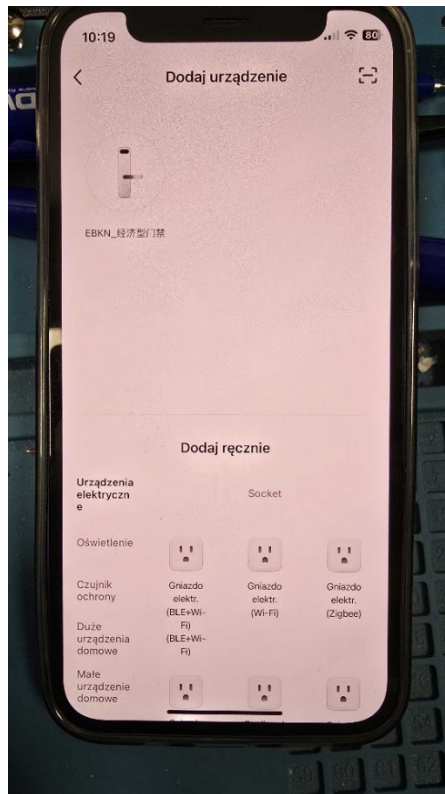
Then, enter the device menu again by pressing the * and # keys and go to the NET option with the 5 key.



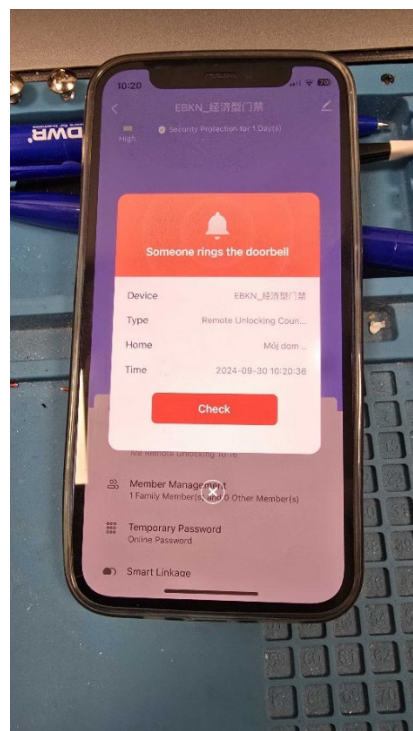
Pressing 1 will start connecting to the app.



After some time, the device will be detected.



Then we choose them to finally add them. From the application level, we can see when someone has opened the door, or is using the doorbell on the keyboard.



Remark! Remote opening of the door is only possible when the user activates the doorbell on the device's keypad.
